Measures to minimize the spread of Covid - 19 in Prisons

The JSC having considered the prevailing situation in Prisons has decided to issue the following guidelines with the aim of minimizing the spread of Covid – 19 in Prisons.

- All Magistrates and Additional Magistrates are required to strictly comply with Section 3 (1) of the Release of Remand Prisoners Act No.8 of 1991.
- In other instances where a person is languishing in remand custody due to his inability to furnish bail, despite bail having been granted by a competent court, Magistrates and High Court Judges may exercise their discretion and order that such bail be furnished within a specific time period, preferably on or before 31st of January 2021, and until such time may consider the release of such person upon entering into a bond without sureties.
